

ROTARY FOUNDATION ADVOCATES

Each Area in Rotary District 7570 should have a RI Foundation Advocate identified by July 1 of each year. A Foundation Advocate's key responsibility is to assist the Area Governor (AG) in educating the clubs on all matters pertaining to The Rotary Foundation (TRF). They should form a good working relationship with the Club Presidents in their Area. If possible, the Foundation Advocate will attend the foundation portion of the President-Elect Learning Session (PELS), District Team Training (DTTS), and Club Team Training (CTT) Zoom sessions. They should also attend the AG meetings with the club presidents.

Advocates are identified by the AG as a Rotarian who strongly supports TRF. They are approved by the District Governor-Elect before the year begins. They work closely with the District Rotary Foundation chair (DRFC). They are appointed each Rotary year but may serve multiple years in this role.
