



Each Area in Rotary District 7570 should have a Youth Advocate identified by July 1 of the Rotary year. A Youth Advocate's key responsibility is to assist the Area Governor (AG) with creating a safe and nurturing culture for the young people our clubs work with. They should form a good working relationship with the Club Presidents in their Area. If possible, the Youth Advocate will attend the Youth portion of the President-Elect Learning Session (PELS), District Team Training (DTTS), and Club Team Training (CTT). They should also attend the AG meetings with the club presidents.

Advocates are identified by the AG as a Rotarian who has been active in youth programs. They are approved by the District Governor-Elect before the year begins. They work closely with the District Youth Services Chair. They are appointed each Rotary year but may serve multiple years in this role.
